**NAVE:** The nave is the main body of the church in which the assembly is seated. In earlier years it was long and narrow, and sometimes cruciform. Since Vatican II it is more likely in newer churches to be more square or even rounded. This is because Vatican II viewed the assembly as a primary symbol of the liturgical celebration and encouraged the seating area to be arranged so that members of the assembly could see one another and serve as witnesses to one another.
