Church of Baptism: If you have ever prepared for a sacrament in your parish, and it is not the parish in which you were baptized, you have been asked to provide a baptismal certificate from your church of baptism. And it must be a recent one. The reason for this is that all major sacramental events are recorded at that church. It provides a centralized source to obtain an individual's sacramental history. That is where one's First Holy Communion, Confirmation, marriage, or annulment will be recorded. When you request a recent baptismal certificate, all this information is included. That way, the parish in which you wish to receive a sacrament can verify that you have whatever is necessary to proceed.
