Mystagogy II : Most of us do not use this word much, if at all. Usually when it is used, it refers to the period of time following the rites of initiation at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. It refers to a time of reflecting upon the rituals involved in celebrating the sacraments and in coming to a fuller understanding and appreciation of what one has experienced. However, the word does not have to refer only to the sacramental celebrations of the Easter Vigil. It can also refer to a “breaking open” of the experience of the other rites along the way to initiation, or even to any process of reflection and understanding of sacred mysteries that have been experienced. Usually this is done in a group setting. For those initiated at the Easter Vigil, this usually comprises the final sessions that they have together between Easter and Pentecost.
